


**BRIDGER TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES FOR A SPECIAL MEETING
HELD ON AUGUST 23, 2016**

The August 23rd, 2016 special meeting of the Bridger Town Council was held at 108 South D Street in Bridger. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the meeting was brought to order by Mayor Shultz at 6:50 pm (Councilman DeRudder was late due to unavoidable circumstances). Council members present were George "Butch" Wilm, Randy Novakovich and Mark DeRudder. Others present were: Delphine Coon, Shala Cullum, Bill Asbury, Laura McElhinny, Lynn White, Melva Lightburn, Library Director Krystal Zentner, Judge Bert Kraft, Police Chief Mike Buechler and Clerk Kirstin Sweet.

The first item on the agenda was public comment on the agenda. There was no public comment from the gallery.

Next, Mayor Shultz asked for comment from the candidates. Each of the three candidates spoke about their experiences and strengths that would make them a good council person. Some discussion was had by the council members regarding the fact that we have 3 good candidates and that this will be a tough decision. After the discussion Councilman Wilm motioned to appoint Shala Cullum as the new council person. Councilman Novakovich seconded the motion.
