

**BRIDGER TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES FOR A PUBLIC HEARING
HELD ON JUNE 5, 2018**

The June 5, 2018 public hearing of the Bridger Town Council was held at 108 South D Street in Bridger. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the meeting was brought to order by Mayor Shultz at 6:30 pm. Council members present were George "Butch" Wilm, Shala Cullum and Doug Asbury. Others present were: Bryant Seymour, Bobby Seymour, Robert Trask, Attorney Hope Freeman, Judge Bert Kraft, Patrol Officer Codi Peters and Clerk Kirstin Sweet.

Mayor Shultz asked for public comment on the proposed zoning ordinances #37 to #48. There was no public comment from the gallery. Some discussion was had regarding the zoning administrator's role and how new construction of items would be regulated under the proposed ordinances.
