

**BRIDGER TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES FOR A SPECIAL MEETING
HELD ON JUNE 19, 2019**

The June 19, 2019 special meeting of the Bridger Town Council was held at 108 South D Street in Bridger. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and the meeting was called to order by Mayor Shultz at 6:30 pm. Council members present were George "Butch" Wilm, Shala Cullum, Mark DeRudder and Doug Asbury. Others present were Audrey Walleser, Brad Dorvall, Steve Fendler and Clerk Kirstin Sweet.

Clerk Sweet began by explaining the need for a decision on the presumptive coverage. Some discussion was had by the council. Audrey Walleser gave public comment regarding her experience with Senate Bill 160 and her wildland firefighting. Steve Fendler, Fire Chief for the Bridger Volunteer Fire Department gave public comment regarding his feelings about the coverage. The council continued discussion. Miss Walleser gave comment again. Mayor Shultz called for a vote. Councilwoman Cullum motioned to reject the coverage for the fiscal year 2019-2020. The motion was seconded by Councilman Wilm. The motion carried with the votes as follows: Councilman Wilm – aye, Councilwoman Cullum – aye, Councilman DeRudder – aye and Councilman Asbury – aye.

There being no further business Councilwoman Cullum motioned to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilman Asbury. The motion carried with the votes as follows: Councilman Wilm – aye, Councilwoman Cullum – aye, Councilman DeRudder – aye and Councilman Asbury – aye. Meeting adjourned at 6:56 pm.
