

**BRIDGER TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES FOR A PUBLIC HEARING
HELD ON OCTOBER 8, 2019**

The October 8, 2019 public hearing of the Bridger Town Council was held at 108 South D Street in Bridger. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and the meeting was brought to order by Mayor Shultz at 6:32 pm. Council members present were George "Butch" Wilm, Shala Cullum, Mark DeRudder and Doug Asbury.
