

BRIDGER TOWN COUNCIL WORK MEETING MINUTES AUGUST 19, 2014

The Bridger Town Council held a work meeting to discuss the water metered rates. There was discussion about the costs of the base rate in comparison to the residential customers. The base rate would need to be raised. A 50,000 gallon threshold was also discussed. The Council decided that if all meter reading would be eliminated, and a median price be utilized, it would be more equitable. A cost of \$34 or \$35 was discussed. A cost per building (apartment complexes) could be utilized. A 20% out of the Town limits charge would be charged also, as infrastructure costs are not being contributed to.

There was also discussion concerning the out of district bulk water fees being so high. A 2 cent out of district charge would be more equitable.
