

BRIDGER TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES FOR DECEMBER 3, 2013

The December 3, 2013 Meeting of the Bridger Town Council was brought to order by Council President Randy Novakovich. Council Members present were George Wilm and Gerry Roth. Others present were Police Chief Mike Buechler, Public Works Director Tim Goldsberry, and Town Clerk Deanna Hay.

Randy Novakovich asked if everyone had read the minutes of the previous meeting. Gerry Roth moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. George Wilm seconded and the vote was George W-yes, Randy N-yes, and Gerry R-yes. Motion carried.

Claims were the next agenda item. The Council discussed the claims. Gerry Roth moved to approve the claims along with the November 2013 Bond payment of \$2356. George Wilm seconded and the vote was George W-yes, Randy N-yes, and Gerry R-yes. Motion carried.

Under Committee Reports, the Area Parks and Recreation will be contacted to get their opinion constructing a warming shed for the skating rink.

There were no citizen advisory reports.

There was no public comment.

The next agenda item was zoning applications. A zoning application was read from Danielle Althoff at 206 E Carbon Ave for a 6 foot backyard privacy fence for an approximate cost of \$700. George Wilm moved to approve the zoning application and meet Bridger code requirements. Gerry Roth seconded and the vote was George W-yes, Randy N-yes, and Gerry R-yes. Motion carried.

Resolution #162 to correct the maximum mill was read. The maximum mill was correctly stated for 200.27 mills total. Gerry Roth moved to accept corrected Resolution #162 with the correct maximum mills total of 200.27. George Wilm seconded and the vote was George W-yes, Randy N-yes, and Gerry R-yes. Motion carried.

There was no public comment.

Town Attorney Hope Freeman was not present.

Clerk Deanna Hay asked if the Council would approve a Christmas Open House on December 18, 2013. The Council approved.

Public Works Director had nothing to report other than the outside warming shed for the skating rink.

Police Chief Mike Buechler reported that the Department was getting some complaints from local residents that had been picked up for speeding.

Mayor DeRudder was not present.

There being no further business George Wilm moved to adjourn at 7:19 PM. Randy Novakovich seconded.
